The Nova Southeastern University (NSU) Master of Health Science program partners with the Bachelor of Applied Science in Health Science - Physician Assistant Studies Concentration to offer a 30-credit track to the M.H.Sc. degree offered at NSU. As the demand for master level health care providers, educators, and administrators continues to grow, the M.H.Sc. curriculum will provide you with a learner-centered educational experience that emphasizes critical-thinking, decision making, leadership, the concept of the scholar-practitioner, and lifelong learning. *** NSU will award 5 Prior Learning credits toward the M.H.Sc. Program's Generalist curriculum degree requirements. Each student will earn a maximum of 5 Prior Learning credit hours that may be applied towards the M.H.Sc. degree. To earn Prior Learning credits from NSU, MDC will submit a log indicating the completion of a minimum of 200 clinical hours, submission of a completed clinical case study from the MDC program and provide proof of meeting all MDC requirements for graduation.
